Important Safety Instructions

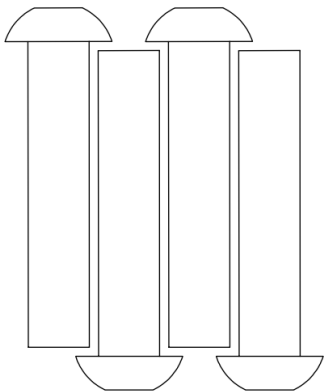
- Read and fully understand all instructions contained in this manual prior to using the product. Be alerted to the possibility of injury. Do not be careless.
- This stand is designed for storing PowerBlock dumbbells with a max weight of 100 LB/45 kg per dumbbell. **Please do not place other goods on the stand.**
- Inspect the stand prior to each use. Do not use a stand with worn, damaged or loose parts, fasteners or hardware.
- Use the stand on a flat and firm surface only. Damage to the products and potential injury may occur.
- Never allow dumbbells to drop freely to the stand. Damage to the product and potential injury may occur.
- Place the dumbbells appropriately on the stand. Do not allow the dumbbells to be placed over the edges of the trays. Damage to the product and potential personal injury may occur.
- Before beginning your workout, make certain that your surroundings are free from potential interference.

- **DO NOT** use any equipment in any way other than as designed or intended by the manufacturer. It is imperative that POWERBLOCK equipment is used properly to avoid injury.
 - Injuries may result if exercising improperly or excessively. It is recommended that all individuals consult a physician prior to commencing an exercise program. If at any time during exercise you feel faint, dizzy or experience pain, STOP EXERCISING and consult your physician.
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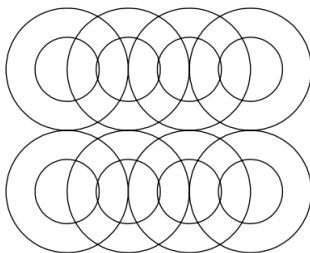

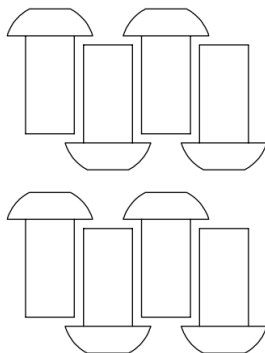

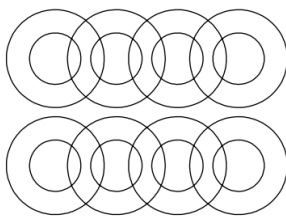

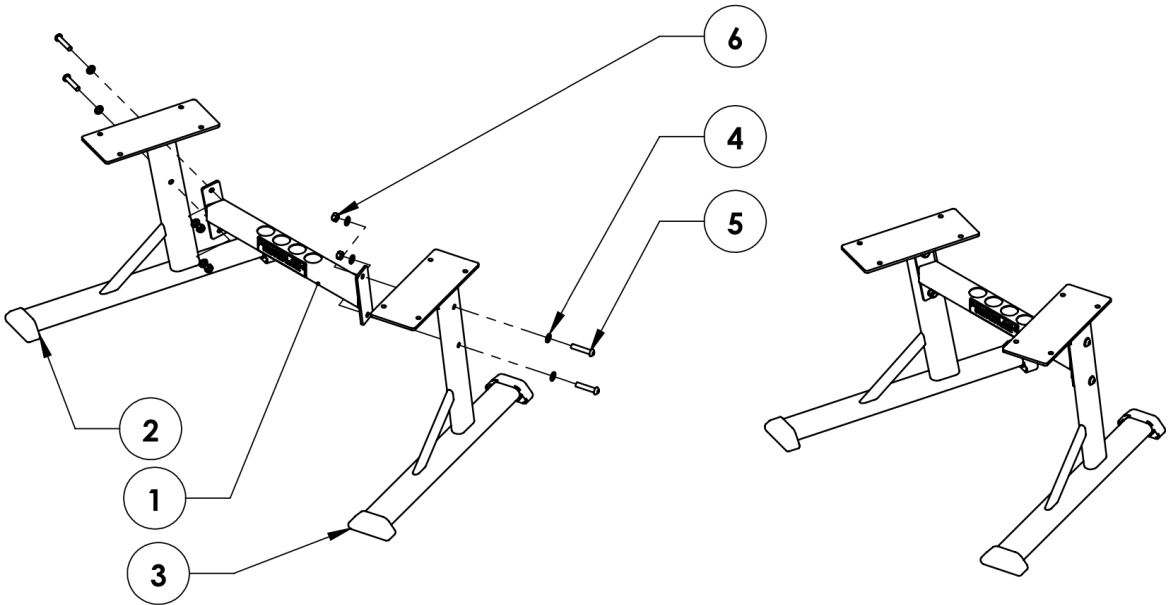
Assembly Instructions

Step 1

Item	Description	Quantity
1	Stand Spacer Support	1
2	Stand Left Leg	1
3	Stand Right Leg	1
4	M10 - 1.5 mm x 50 mm Button Head Screws	4
5	M10 Washers	8
6	M10 - 1.5 mm Lock Nuts	4

TOOLS NEEDED: One 17 mm wrench and one 6 mm hex allen head wrench (Included in hardware kit)

1. Attach left leg (Item 2) to spacer support (Item 1) with supplied hardware. **DO NOT tighten hardware.**
2. Attach right leg (Item 3) to spacer support (Item 4) with supplied hardware.
3. **Tighten all hardware.**



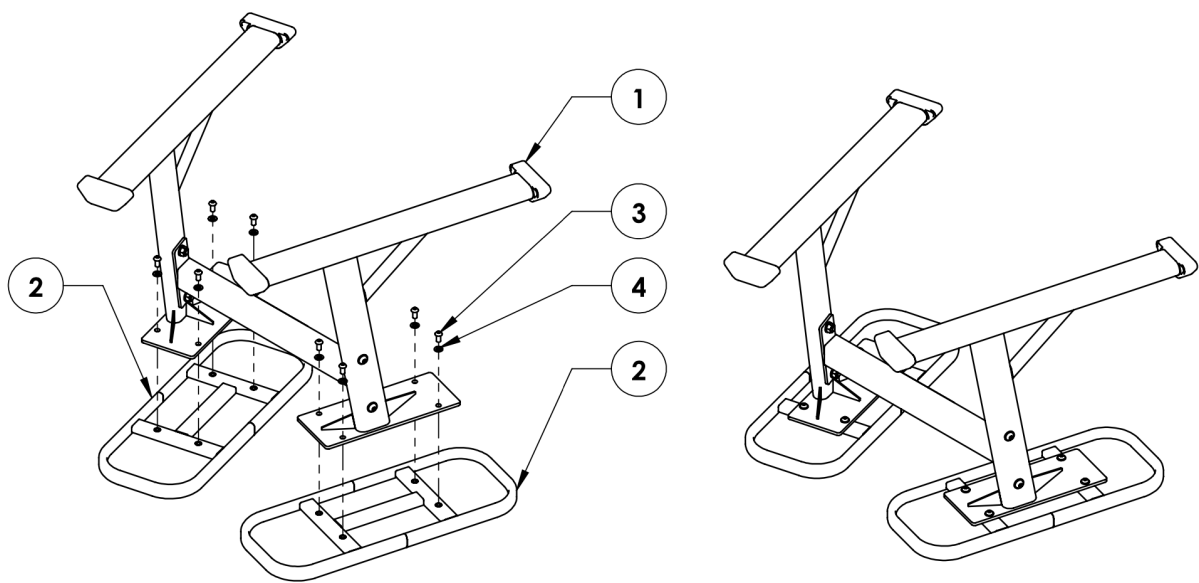
Step 2

Item	Description	Quantity
1	Stand Leg Assembly	1
2	Stand Trays	2
3	M8 Button Head Screws	8
4	M8 Washers	8

TOOLS NEEDED: One 5 mm allen head wrench.

- 1. Place both stand tops upside down on a flat surface.
- 2. Attach both trays (Item 2) to leg assembly (Item 1) with supplied hardware.
- 3. **Tighten all hardware.**

For use on firm and flat surface only.



Maintenance Procedures

Maintenance Schedule

Inspect Daily

- Inspect the stand prior to each use. Do not use a stand with worn, damaged or loose parts, fasteners or hardware.

Once a week

- Visually inspect all hardware for loosening, tampering or wear.

Once a Month

- Inspect hardware and tighten any bolts that may have loosened over the life of the product.

Cleaning

A soft microfiber cloth and warm water can be used to keep your stand clean.

DO NOT use ammonia or acid-based cleaners.

DO NOT use abrasive cleaners or an abrasive cloth.

DO NOT use paper towels.

DO NOT apply cleaners directly to the equipment surfaces.
